## "Global Summit on Disinformation 2023: A call to action to strengthen democracy"

The third edition of the **Global Summit on Disinformation** will be held on September 27 and 28, 2023, and it is organized by the <u>Inter-American Press Association</u>, the <u>Foundation for Journalism (Bolivia)</u> and <u>Proyecto Desconfío (Argentina)</u>. The event is supported by Google News Initiative, International Fact-Checking Network and UN Argentina. It is online and free with previous registration in this **form**.

Disinformation has become a challenge for democratic life on a global scale. For this reason, the main objective of this global event is to share the **news**, **achievements**, **and challenges in the fight against disinformation** and to work together with the actors involved, betting on consolidating a media and news system that can stop this problem.

The activity is especially intended for journalists, researchers, academics, factcheckers, media and government representatives, civil society organizations, professors, and students interested in the subject.

The 2023 Summit will include talks, a round of journalistic projects, workshops, panels, and roundtable discussions around 5 topics:

- 1) Electoral disinformation: a threat to democracy.
- 2) "If It doesn't spread is dead": The challenge of building effective verified content distribution strategies.
- 3) Recovering trust in the age of disinformation: How to create news quality indicators.
- 4) Verification in the age of AI: challenges and solutions.
- 5) Media literacy: making audiences literate in times of Tik-Tok.

More than **20 international speakers** will present during the event. Among them, representatives of the International Fact-Checking Network (IFCN), Trusting News, International Center for Journalists (ICFJ), Content Authenticity Initiative (CAI); Deutsche Welle Akademie (DW), Europa Press, Disarming Disinformation, Google News Initiative (GNI); United Nations Argentina (UN); Bolivia Verifica, among others.

In 2022, the Summit brought together more than 700 participants from countries in the Americas, Europe, and Asia, with international speakers such as Craig Silverman (Propublica, USA), Sally Lehrman (The Trust Project, USA), Cristina Tardaguila (ICFJ), Scott Hale (Meedan-Oxford Institute, UK), Rosental Alves (Knight Center), among others.

The edition of this year's Global Summit on Disinformation is accompanied by the International Center for Journalists (ICFJ), the National Press Association of Chile, the United States Embassy; GABO Foundation, DW Akademie, Infoveritas; the Colombian Association of Media Information (AMI), the Association of Argentine Journalistic Entities (ADEPA), Medianálisis, and Bolivia Verifica.
